Health and Safety

- Incorporate health and safety into each action we undertake: no activity is so important or urgent that it cannot be done appropriately, healthily, and safely.

- Report immediately any potential safety hazards, near misses, environmental risks, and incidents to EHS representatives for remediation.

- Provide employees with regular training on their jobs' environmental, health, and safety aspects.
- Consult and collaborate with employees and other stakeholders.

Supplier Management

• Ensure our contractors, vendors, and suppliers share our commitment by including environmental, health, and safety criteria in our supplier management selection and evaluation processes.

Continual Improvement

• Set challenging targets and promote a Plan-Do-Check-Act systematic approach at all organizational levels to ensure continual improvement.
